- Office towers and businesses along the parade route (marine-related, restaurants, entertainment and historical landmarks)
- Downtown ground-floor, storefront businesses
- Downtown cultural institutions
- Boats along the New River
- Downtown office towers

Awards will be given in the following categories:

- Best Multi Unit Residential Building (under 200 units)
- Best Multi Unit Residential Building (over 200 units)
- Business Creative Award (Best restaurant, retail/merchant and/or boat)
- Best Office Building Low Rise (under four stories)
- Best Office Building High Rise (four stories or higher)
